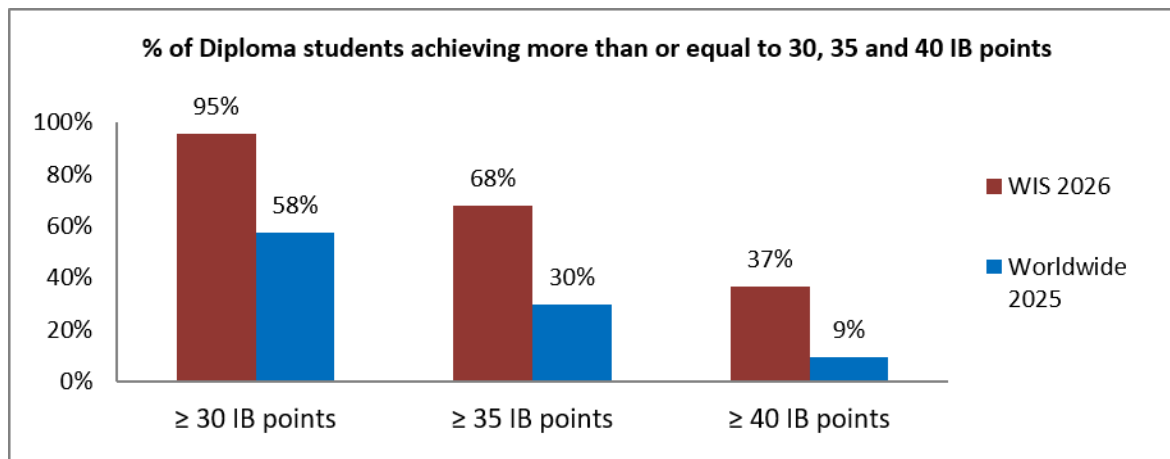
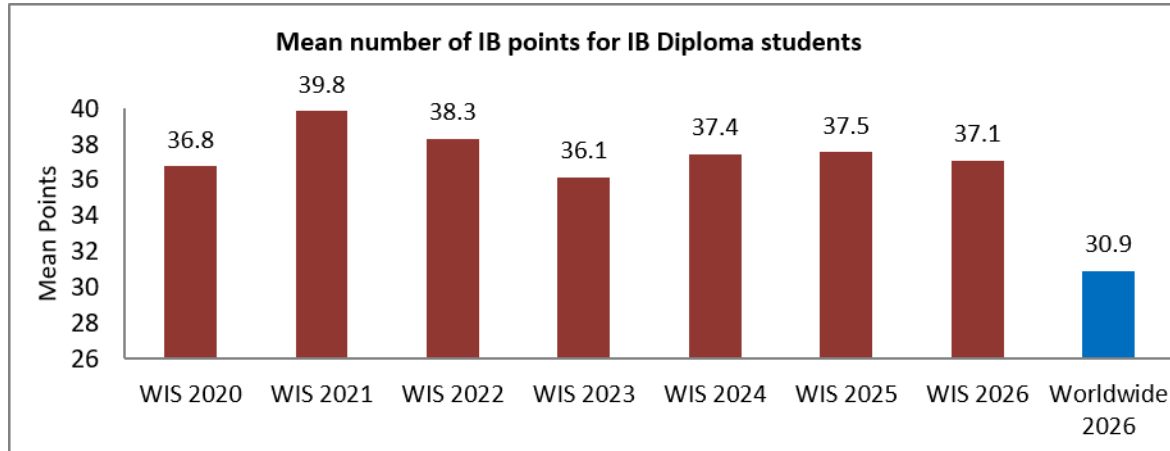
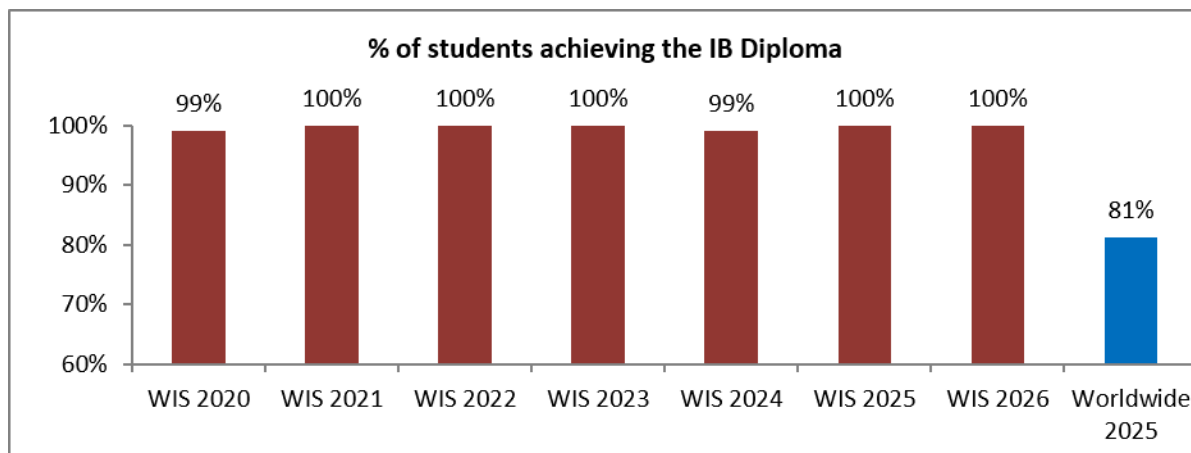


IBDP, IBCP and BTEC Results: May 2026 - West Island School

Note: worldwide 2026 data is not yet available (except for the mean number of IB points per student).



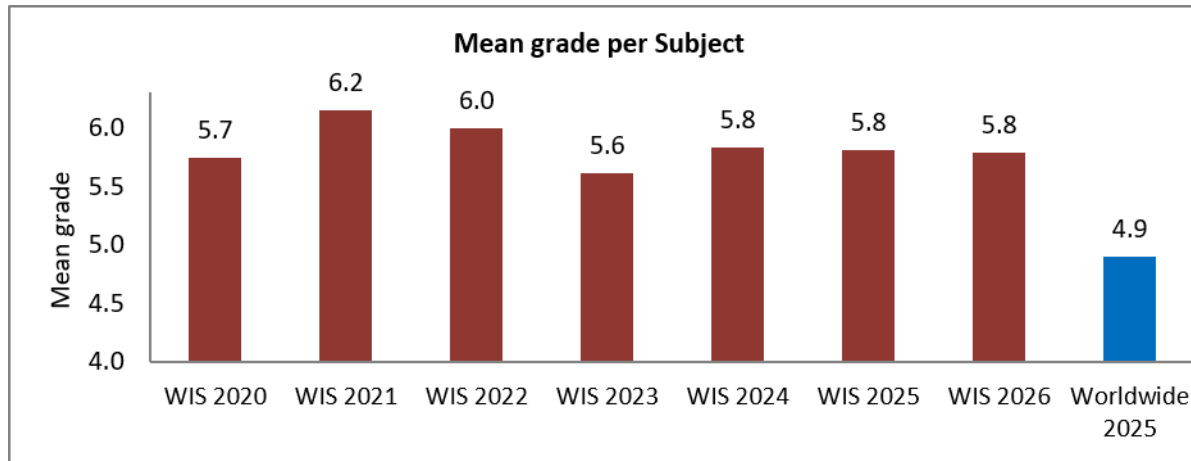

IB Diploma Programme

Students study six subjects at either Higher Level (HL) or Standard Level (SL). The programme enables students to develop knowledge across a range of disciplines. Not only highly valued by the world's leading universities for its rigor and development of research skills, IB students also understand the importance of service and action.

As well as studying individual subject areas, students write an extended essay exploring an area of personal interest: 62% of candidates achieved an A or B grade for their essay (40% Worldwide). Students also follow a course to explore 'Theory of Knowledge': 60% were awarded an A or B in their final assessment (47.4% Worldwide).

Congratulations to Joshua Chow, Yik Ki Ho and Jonathan Huang who achieved an amazing score of 45 points. This is an outstanding achievement that puts each of them in the top 0.5% of IB candidates worldwide.

A special mention goes to the five students who were awarded the Bilingual Diploma and assessed in their first language for the language component. Congratulations to Stefano Leone, Chun Yiu Li, Tzi Yeung Ng, Sin Tung Tallis Shum and Tin Yu Shum.

IB Career-related Programme

Year 13 students can study a Level 3 BTEC qualification (equivalent to UK A Level) and combine this with IB Diploma Courses. This is called the International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme (IBCP). Those interested in following the IBCP can tailor their programmes to pursue individual passions and interests, choosing pathways that include BTEC courses in Business Studies, Sports & Exercise Science, Digital Design and Creative Media. The qualification is valued highly by a wide range of competitive universities and recognised for developing high levels of independence with analytical and evaluation skills applied to the subject area.

23 students have been awarded the IBCP this year. Congratulations to our top IBCP performers Nga Ying Alena Cheng, Stephanie McNicol, Charlotte Case and Ella Snelgrove.

BTEC

Year 13 students can also opt to study a combination of BTEC Diploma and Subsidiary Diploma qualifications (equivalent to 3 UK A Levels) and have the option to add in extra IB courses. Congratulations to the top performers, Hilward Lau and Maximilian Marthinussen.
